Honors Independent Study Abroad Guidelines:

- 1. Eligibility
 - Only a Full-time faculty member (professor, assistant professor, associate professor, senior lecturer, or lecturer) is eligible to supervise an Honors Independent Study Abroad (HON3000). Exceptions are made at the discretion of the Honors College. This course will be used to complete the student's Field Learning requirement as part of the University Honors curriculum.
- 2. The Honors Independent Study Abroad Proposal form —
 The Honors Independent Study Abroad Proposal form is available in the Honors
 College (Rm 2100 UGL) and online (http://www.honors.wayne.edu). Once
 completed, the proposal must be signed by both the instructor and the student.
 The student will return the form to the Honors College (Rm 2100 UGL) no later
 than the end of the third week of classes during the semester the Honors
 Independent Study Abroad is to be completed. The student must attach a copy of
 the written Honors Independent Study Abroad proposal. The Honors independent
 study abroad proposal will then be evaluated by Honors College administration
 for approval. The student will receive e-mail notification by the end of the fifth
 week of classes with a decision about the approval of the course. Students are
 strongly encouraged to complete this form as soon as possible, preferably before
 the independent study begins.
- 3. Evaluation
 - An Honors independent study abroad will be graded by the supervising faculty member at the end of the semester the proposal is submitted. The supervising faculty member must send an e-mail to honors@wayne.edu by the end of finals week indicating the student's grade for the Honors independent study abroad. In the e-mail, please include: the student's name, nine-digit student ID number, and grade for the independent study.

Honors Independent Study Abroad Timeline:

- Third week of classes: completed Honors independent study abroad proposals are due to the Honors College
- Fifth week of classes: e-mail confirmation of Honors independent study abroad approval or denial will be sent to students
- Thirteenth week of classes: e-mail with evaluation procedure will be sent to students and faculty
- Sixteenth week of classes: evaluation of Honors independent study abroad is due by faculty to honors@wayne.edu
