

- Offered for many GenEds
- -Always in the 500s
- -Smaller class sizes
- Designed for Honors students
- Use "Honors" filter in class schedule



### HOW DO I FIND HONORS CLASSES?



- Leave subject blank or enter one
- Check "open sections only"
- Include Honors section in the attribute box
- Search and find

## **Honors Option**

- Select a course: 2000-level or higher
  - Taught by full-time or part-time faculty (not GTA or GRA)
  - It's a class you already need!
- Add a Project, agreed upon by you and instructor
- Download the form at <a href="https://honors.wayne.edu/students/forms">https://honors.wayne.edu/students/forms</a>
  - Submit completed Proposal to the Honors College by the deadline
- Earn B or better in course and on project
- That course and its credits become Honors
- Great way to create a relationship with instructor for mentoring, research, and even letters of recommendation
