Honors Option

- Select a course: 2000-level or higher
 - Taught by full-time or part-time faculty (not GTA or GRA)
 - It's a class you already need!
- Add a Project, agreed upon by you and instructor
- Download the form at <https://honors.wayne.edu/students/forms>
 - Submit completed Proposal to the Honors College by the deadline
- Earn B or better in course and on project
- That course and its credits become Honors
- Great way to create a relationship with instructor – for mentoring, research, and even letters of recommendation
