Honors in German & Slavic Studies (15 credits minimum)

The Honors Program in German and Slavic Studies is open to students of superior academic ability who are majoring in this department. Students must maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.3. He/she must accumulate at least fifteen credits in honors-designated course work, including at least one 4000-level seminar offered through the Honors College (see the Schedule of Classes under 'Honors Program' for seminar topics), and the Departmental credits associated with completion of a Senior Thesis.

Required courses:

HON 42XX (3 cr.) Honors Seminar
 At least one 4200-level seminar is offered each Fall and Winter semester. The faculty instructor chooses the topic, which appears in the Schedule of Classes (www.classschedule.wayne.edu)

HON 4998 (3-6 cr.) Honors Thesis
 The Honors Thesis must be at least 20 pages long and written with the guidance of a full-time faculty member from any department.
