Department requirements (15 credits minimum)

History Department offers a Bachelor of Arts degree 'With Honors in History.' Qualified students planning post-baccalaureate work in history or in a professional school are especially encouraged to obtain an Honors degree. Honors majors must additionally have a 3.5 grade point average (g.p.a.) in history courses and a 3.3 cumulative g.p.a. in all courses.

- At least one HON 42XX interdepartmental Honors seminar (3 cr.)
- HIS 5995 (Honors Seminar), taken after HIS 5996 (Capstone Course). Students in the Honors Seminar will complete a senior thesis begun in HIS 5996. This thesis will be directed by two regular faculty members; the student will also defend the thesis before them. (3 cr.)
- A minimum of 6 additional credits earned in History, with at least one upper-Division Honors Option History course.

Students in good standing as well as those in honors are invited to join WSU's chapter of Phi Alpha Theta, the international honor society in history.

University Honors Co-major (24 credits minimum)

The Bachelor of Arts in History Honors with University Honors co-major requires an additional 9honors credits in any department.
