Two ways to become a member of the Irvin D. Reid Honors College:

- **By invitation:** to high school seniors invited to join the College after attending Scholars Day; these students <u>do not</u> need to apply
- **By application:** for current WSU students or transfer students who have a 3.30 post-secondary GPA or higher

Incoming freshmen will need to complete at least one semester at WSU prior to applying. Transfer students should submit a copy of their transcript with applications.

You may be a member of both the Honors College and also pursue departmental Honors in your major.

Application Deadlines:

Applications may be submitted year-round and will be processed on a rolling basis. You will be notified of your acceptance via e-mail.

Processing deadlines:

October 15 (for Winter Pre-Priority Registration) February 15 (for Fall Pre-Priority Registration) June 15

You may earn Honors credits while waiting for your application to be processed. Requests for permission to register for Honors classes should be sent to <u>honors@wayne.edu</u>. Please include your name, WSU ID and the course reference number (CRN) of the Honors section for which you wish to register.

Application for membership in the Irvin D. Reid Honors College

- Please include a copy of your current college transcript displaying a cumulative GPA of 3.30 or higher
- Honors credits from other institutions may be considered towards department Honors, but the HON 4200-level Honors seminar and thesis must be completed in residence at WSU
- Acceptance to the Honors College will not affect your financial aid or scholarship status
- See your department advisor for information about Honors requirements for your major (department Honors) or visit honors.wayne.edu
