Department Requirements (15 credits minimum)

Most of the Social Work Honors Program work will be accomplished by Honors Option, which creates an individual Honors plan of work between the instructor and the Honors student. For the Honors Option guidelines, please go to www.honors.wayne.edu under "Forms"

- Students must be admitted to the School of Social Work
- Must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.5
- At least one HON 42XX interdepartmental Honors seminar (3 cr.)
- 9 credits of Honors Option from the SW program
- Honors Option thesis with SW 4997 (WI) Integrative Seminar in Social Work (departmental capstone course, 3 cr.). Students will make arrangements with the SW faculty of their choice on a minimum 20-page research paper. The Honors Option proposal form should be submitted to identify the faculty member with a brief outline of the topic to be explored.

The Honors Option notation will be added to SW 4997 to indicate the thesis requirement has been met.
