The student will normally be required to have a) a minimum grade point average of 3.3, b) credit in at least three philosophy courses, and c) a `B' or better average in philosophy courses. To remain in the philosophy honors program, the student must maintain a `B' or better average in philosophy courses.

To receive an Honors Degree in Philosophy, the candidate must:

- Complete the course requirements for the regular major in Philosophy
- PHI 4870 (Honors Directed Reading);
- PHI 4890 (Honors Proseminar), to be taken in the candidate's senior year.
- Pass a comprehensive examination in Philosophy.
- Write an Honors Essay of sufficiently high quality on a topic to be chosen by the candidate in consultation with his/her instructor in PHI 4870
