- Under the direction of one or more members of the department, conduct library or laboratory research (PSY 4991) and a senior honors paper (PSY 4998).
 Note: PSY 4998 requires a grade of "B" or better
- Complete one 4200-level Honors seminar offered through the Honors Program.
- Complete PSY 5020 Research Methods in Psychology Honors
- One Honors Course or Honors Options course within the Psychology major, taught by a full-time faculty member, cannot be PSY 4991. (3-4 cr.)
- Accumulate at least eighteen total credits in honorsdesignated course work specifically including PSY 4991, PSY 4998, PSY 5020, one 3 or 4 credit PSY course, and one HON 4200 level seminar. Other honors credit can be obtained from any department.
