- Scholarship packages will vary according to which scholarship you may be selected.
- Students must have a completed FAFSA on file at the Office of Student Financial Aid

Scholarships will be awarded for the Fall 2018 and Winter 2019 terms. Spring/Summer terms will not be covered.
